


# KHAS T'AN HORSEMANSHIP SERVICES



## Horsemanship Workshops

**Khas T'an Horsemanship** offers a variety of different horsemanship services. With qualified hands on deck, each horse and student will have an opportunity to participate in a focused educational environment enhancing their experience in a very natural and positive way that will maintain long term with commitment and practice.

**Horsemanship Workshops** are customized educational programs that provide students with a unique modern learning experience exploring traditional horsemanship techniques that are rooted in 'horse first' philosophies.



These workshops are for the horse enthusiasts who want to take their horsemanship to the next level and is offered to students who are serious about their horsemanship studies and who are not afraid of crossing the silly bridge of their comfort zone and making mistakes in their desire to self improve with their horses.

The following excerpt is out of the book *True Horsemanship Through Feel* authored by renowned horseman, Bill Dorrance, and Leslie Desmond. It is a good description of our learning process and how it affects how we progress with the horse.

*'From the horse's point of view, when there's lack of understandable human feel combined with an intolerance of mistakes that he has no idea about in the first place, and where there's punishments added onto that, well, I'd say it just reduces the chances for a meaningful connection between a horse and a human right down to zero. Mistakes are an important part of learning. It's best if a person doesn't get discouraged by the idea of making mistakes or needing to have to start at the bottom, because that's where the horse learns to understand your feel. You build right onto that and you proceed up the line together from there. A person who has spent some extra time thinking about these things ahead of time, before actually getting with that horse they're going to work with, why they aren't liable to stay for too long in one place. They'll be progressing on up the line.'*

Activities are customized for the students' individual horsemanship goals and learning desires and based on student ability. Safety and fun are key goals in our school activities.

Workshops are available for 4 to 10 students. The objective is to keep classes small to ensure a focused and intimate learning environment for students, which is an integral part of the workshop curriculum. Students will have exposure to a variety of different learning experiences with their horses and in the classroom. Quality is important and prioritized over quantity to increase efficacy in the students' learning process.



Students must be 16 years old or older unless otherwise discussed with Kyla. Students should be in decent physical condition ready for lots of horsemanship activity and riding. Each workshop day will include an open and innovative curriculum with emphasis on learning opportunities as they arise with the horses. Students can book workshops on a first-come-first-serve basis.
